
Warrior Preparation - Read chapter 19 of the Warrior book. Read 1 Samuel 17:45-47; Revelation 12:7-12; John 12:30-33, 14:30-31, 16:33, 1 John 5:1-5

Discussion Questions: (Discuss the following question and points from the chapter)

- Read 1 Samuel 17:45-47 in the group and go through it line by line. How could David be so sure he was going to win that day?
- We are warriors, and we need to fight, but the Bible says the battle is God's. How does that knowledge increase our confidence?
- In light of the verses listed in Warrior Preparation, discuss this concept: Satan is a defeated foe.
- Satan may be defeated, but we still have to fight him. Read James 4:7. How does this verse help us?
- Discuss this statement: As warriors, we must believe God is willing, ready and able to help us. Do we accept God's heart for us? If not, why? Is our reason bigger than God's promise?

Warrior Decisions:

- I believe and trust that the battle is not mine, but God's
- I will live my life and carry myself with confidence of a winner, not a loser.
- I will believe that Jesus defeated Satan on the cross and by his resurrection, and will live my life accordingly.
- When Satan attacks, I will resist him, knowing he will eventually flee and the victory will be mine.
