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The Relationship between the Church and the Kingdom
The kingdom should be top priority in our lives
 Peter made repentance and baptism (born again) the keys to both the kingdom and
the body of Christ <u>Matthew 16:13-20, Acts 2:38</u> (Jn 3:5-8), <u>1 Cor 12:12-13</u>
The kingdom and body are one. The body is the churchEphesians 1:22-23
The Bible interchangeably refers to the church, the body and the kingdom. On earth,
the church is the representation of the kingdom of heaven, so it is also top priority
The Body of Christ: pick the right head, stick to the body Ephesians 1:22-23
 If Jesus is not the head, the body is dead. We must stick with the body to stay
alive in Christ. The finger cannot survive apart from the body
Pick the church with Jesus as the HeadEphesians 2:19-22
 Jesus is the head, if the Foundation is the Bible(Ephesians 2:20-22)
 The church must accurately teach the Word of God(1 Timothy 4:16)
 Salvation: Hear, Believe, Repent, Confess Jesus is Lord, Be Baptized
If the church does not teach Gods' plan of salvation, Jesus is not the head
• Jesus is the head, if the Family is in the Fellowship(Ephesians 2:19)
 Jesus called God's followers his family members Matthew 12:48-50 If the church is not building spiritual, loving relationships, Jesus is not the head
• Focus on One Body that has the right foundation and familyEphesians 4:3-6
Make every effort to be unified with one church
Why do over 450 denominations exist in the U.S., alone?
There should be no division(1 Corinthians 1:10-13)
 We should not hop or shop churches or fellowships. Be united with one church that
 that teaches salvation correctly
 is devoted to building family in the fellowship
Stick with the body to stay alive in ChristEphesians 4:1-3
 Making every effort out of love is called devotion
Devoted to the Fellowship
Church Attendance: Do not miss the meetings of the body
 God thinks habitually missing church is serious, deliberate sin (Hebrews 10:26-31 Be supportive of church leadership and practices. (Hebrews 13:17, 13:7.8)
 Be supportive of church leadership and practices (Hebrews 13:17, 13:7-8) Devoted to Faith Partnerships and Discipling
After we are baptized, we are to be taught to obey everything (Matthew 28:18-20)
New Christians need more training for spiritual maturity(Hebrews 5:11-14)
• Every day connect with each other at a heart-to-heart level
We need to initiate getting discipling so we can mature in building faith partnerships
Devoted to Daily Encouragement
See the good and encourage each other every day(Hebrews 3:12-13)
Devote time to honoring and loving one another
Devoted to Small Group Membership
Serving together as a small group in the mission

• Faithfully speaking God's Word impacts unbelievers (1 Corinthians 14:24-25)
Serving: Everyone in the church finds a way to serve
 Ushers, Audio/Visual, Children's Ministry, Communications, Worship
Teaching: We need to help each other spiritually (Romans 15:14, Colossians 3:16)
Encouraging: See above "Devoted to Encouragement"
Contributing to meet needs: Giving financially
 Financially, God expects us to be faithful and reliable
 Planning helps with reliable giving(1 Corinthians 16:1-2)
 At times, collections are made to meet special needs: missionary work, disaster
relief, helping the poor, expanding the church (2 Corinthians 8:13-15, Acts 4:34)
 How much should be given? A tithe is good starting point in deciding what to give
Tithing is the practice of giving the first tenth of your income to God
Tithing reminds us that everything we have is a gift from God
♦ Jesus told the Pharisees they should practice the tithe(Luke 11:42)
♦ He commended those who sacrificed financially for the church(Mark 12:41-44)
♦ God wants to bless us when we responsibly sacrifice
Leading: We can lead in our areas of strength
Mercy: Helping the poor and needy was part of Christ's mission (Matthew 25:31-46)
• From time to we participate in programs to help the poor locally and worldwide
Devoted to Peace and Unity (Romans 12:18-21)
We make every effort to live at peace with each other
Work to resolve matters with people quickly and directly(Matthew 5:25-26)
• Involve others when you cannot resolve matters personally Matthew 18:15-16
♦ Devoted to Purity (primarily for the unmarried)
 We honor one another with our purity (Romans 12:10) 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8 Treat the opposite gender with absolute purity like family (1 Timothy 5:1.2)
■ Do not be yoked with unbelievers
The call to absolute purity, undivided devotion, being yoked with only believers and for widows to only marry disciples, strongly suggests that it is in the Spirit of Christ
to (1) expect disciples to date only other disciples and (2) practice double-dating
only disciples so that one another's purity is honored
