# **GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE**

#### **Conversation Starter**

 What is your favorite movie or what is the latest movie you have watched?

#### **Review the Sermon**

Take a few minutes with your community group to share what spoke to you from the sermon, a phrase or point from the sermon you related to the most, or questions you might have.

#### Make It Personal

- 1. **Read Mark 3:1-6**. God will often address a broken situation to confront a dysfunctional system. Has God ever intervened to confront a dysfunctional system in your life? Share one thing you have seen God address in your life that was causing other areas of your faith to suffer.
- 2. In Mark 3, Jesus was looking for someone to heal. The Pharisees were looking for a way to accuse Jesus. Both found what they were looking for. On a day-to-day basis, how much of your faith is a result of what you naturally focus on? What do you do every day to fix your focus on the right things?
- 3. Faith is not meant to be reserved for a special occasion; it is meant to be used every day. Finish these sentences:

One aspect of my faith I need to use more often is \_\_\_\_\_.

#### Act On It

Jesus commanded the man in Mark 3 to stand up and to stretch his hand. When he stretched his hand, he was healed. Likewise, God will often command us to stand up, stretch, and believe Him before we see Him move. This isn't easy to do. The challenge this week is to do something that you couldn't do without faith. Share with the group what that one thing is.

Ask your group to share any prayer requests they have. Record any notes or prayer requests to pray for them during the week.
