Romans 5:6-8

- Q: How does God demonstrate his love for us?
- While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- Q: How does that make you feel?

The Passion of Christ

Matthew 26:36-46

- · Jesus was preparing himself to go to the Cross.
- Q: What was Jesus feeling in this moment?
- Jesus is the model of putting God's will above His own.

Matthew 26:47-56

• Jesus is arrested and all of His friends abandon Him.

Matthew 26:69-75

• Jesus is denied by His best friend.

Matthew 26:11-26

- · Jesus remained silent for you and me. (V14)
- We are Barrabas! (V16)
- Pilate had the power to release Jesus, but he wanted to please the crowd. (v24)

Matthew 27:27-31

- Q: How do you think Jesus felt when He was mocked? (v29)
- Q: How do we mock Jesus?

Matthew 27:32-44

Q: How would Jesus feel that there was no one to help Him? (v32)

• The death of Jesus on the cross was not enough for some people to believe. (v42)

Matthew 27:45-46

- Jesus was separated from God and put into darkness for your sin. (v46)

Our Response to the Cross

1 Peter 2:21-25

Q: What should be our response to the cross?

• The Cross should motivate us to die to our sins and live for righteousness.

2 Corinthians 5:14-15

Q: What does the word compel mean?

Christ's love compels us to stop living for ourselves and start living for God. What does
that look like for you personally?
