John 1:1-5

Q: Who is the Word that John is talking about?

Q: What can we learn about Jesus from this passage?

John 14:6-7

Q: What is Jesus saying about himself?

- The only way to know God is through Jesus.

John 8:31-32

Q: How do you know if someone is a true disciple of Jesus?

Q: What does it mean to hold to Jesus' teachings?

- A true disciple not only believes in Jesus, but obeys his teachings.

The Word is Useful and Relevant

2 Timothy 3:16-17

Q: What do you think "all Scripture is God-breathed" means?

- All scripture is inspired by God.

Q: What is scripture useful for?

- Daily application of the Bible will equip you for a righteous life.

Hebrews 4:12-13

Q: What does it mean for the Bible to be alive and active?

Q: How is the Bible like a sword?

- The Bible cuts our hearts, reveals our thoughts and attitudes and heals us.
- We each will give an account to God.
