- A true disciple not only believes in Jesus, but obeys his teachings.

- Q: What do you think "all Scripture is God-breathed" means?
- All scripture is inspired by God.
- **Q**: What is scripture useful for?
- Daily application of the Bible will equip you for a righteous life.

Hebrews 4:12-13

- **Q**: What does it mean for the Bible to be alive and active?
- Q: How is the Bible like a sword?
- The Bible cuts our hearts, reveals our thoughts and attitudes and heals us.
- We each will give an account to God.
