DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Conversation Starters

- Do you like to travel? When you travel, do you tend to over-pack or do you tend to forget things?

Sermon Discussion

- Read Matthew 9:35-38, Matthew 10:5-10 MSG
- 1. In Matthew 10:5-10, Jesus gives his 12 disciples instruction, and he concludes by saying, "Travel light." Sometimes we carry too much—whether it's emotionally or spiritually—there are things that slow us down or distract us from God's mission. What are one or two things God may be asking you to lay down so you can travel light and walk in obedience?
- 2. **Many times God will give you the direction before he gives you the details.** Can you think of a time in your life when God asked you to take a step of faith before you had the full picture? What did that experience teach you about trust, control, and dependence on God?
- 3. In the Old Testament, God portrays himself generationally—the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Also, in 1 Corinthians 9:24–27, Paul likens our faith to running a race. However, the race of faith is not a solo sprint, it's more like a relay race. Why do you think God emphasizes generational impact in how he reveals himself and works through his people? Whether you are a parent, mentor, or church member, what does it look like to prepare others to run their leg of the race?
- 4. The exchange zone—the moment of passing the baton—is critical in both relay races and our faith journey. Mike shared that 85% of Jesus followers come to faith before age 18. How should this shape the priorities of our church and community? What can our church do better to ensure the baton of faith is passed to the next generation?
- 5. Hebrews 12:1-2 encourages us to throw off every weight that is slowing us down. What are some weights in your life—like **sin, isolation, or shortsightedness**—that may be slowing down your race of faith? How does keeping your eyes on Jesus help you endure pain, pressure, or temptation?
