DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Conversation Starters

• Do you remember your first cell phone? What kind was it?

Sermon Discussion

- Read 1 Corinthians 4:14-17, Romans 8:1
- 1. In 1 Corinthians 4:14-17, Paul writes to the Corinthian church as a spiritual father correcting and guiding his children in a culture full of conflicting voices. Why do you think spiritual fatherhood was so crucial for the Corinthian church? Why is spiritual fatherhood still so needed in our church today?
- 2. Technology has greatly impacted our culture, particularly how social media gives everyone a platform and voice. We have many so called "experts" giving advice and opinions, but few Godly examples. How do you see social media influencing people's understanding of leadership and authority in our culture today? How can we discern the difference between spiritual authority and just another opinion?
- 3. Discipleship and modeling are critical for fathers and leaders. Who is someone in your life that modeled faith for you—not just telling you what to do, but showing you how to live?
- 4. We must get rid of the old mindset that all wisdom must come from the lead pastor, instead we need many "Paul's" in the church. How does this shift from one central leader to a community of spiritual fathers and mothers change your view of your role in the church? What qualities make someone a spiritual father or mother, regardless of their age or title?
- 5. Here are the three sermon points about spiritual fatherhood:
- A spiritual father warns and does not shame. Share about a time when someone corrected you in a way that brought life and encouragement rather than shame.
- A spiritual father brings life through the gospel. Why do you think it is so powerful when a leader admits their own weaknesses and asks for forgiveness?
- A spiritual father leads by example. Who is someone that God might be calling you to come alongside and say, "Follow me—I will walk with you"? Reach out to them this week!
