DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Conversation Starters

- What is something small that instantly steals your peace (traffic, slow WiFi, empty fridge, clutter around the house, etc)?

Sermon Discussion

- **Read:** Acts 12:1-16

1. In Acts 12 James was executed while Peter was rescued, reminding us that even faithful followers of Jesus do not always experience the same outcome. Faith doesn't eliminate hard questions, but it gives us Someone to trust in the middle of them. Can you think of a season that didn't make sense, and what did God teach you through it?
2. The early church's first response to Peter's imprisonment was earnest prayer, reminding us that prayer was their first instinct, not their last resort. Oftentimes our first response is worry or control instead of bringing our needs to God. What is usually your first response when life gets difficult, and what would it look like to make prayer your first response this week?
3. Peter had every reason to panic, yet on the night before his trial he was found sleeping peacefully. His confidence wasn't rooted in his situation, but in God's presence and faithfulness. What is currently stealing your peace? What would it look like to practically rest in Christ before your situation changes?
4. Peter was told to get up and obey before the chains ever fell off. Throughout Scripture, God often invites us to trust Him with the next step before revealing the whole plan. Is there an area of your life where God may be asking you to obey before you fully understand what He is doing?
5. The church in Acts 12 responded to hardship by gathering together, praying earnestly, and carrying one another's burdens. A mature church doesn't face difficult seasons alone but leans into community and prayer. How can our group better support one another this week, and what is one specific way we can be praying for each other?
